Swing Tarturo's music sounds like an old crank gramophone or a crazy, derailed cabaret from the 1930s spiced up with a handful of punk. Their repertoire has in the recent years developed towards an emphasis on the compositions in the same tradition by the band's singer Julia Stokes and on the album Operation Vision the old classics have been phased out with the exception of one song. The 1936 song Strange Fruit with it's anti-racism protest being still very relevant. The fusion between the bold and honest lyrics about equality, empathy and the anxiety of everyday life, and the inventive and often humorous music creates an exciting and striking collection of songs.

Since the birth in 2009 Swing Tarturo has been a heavily engaged live act around Scandinavia, renowned for their strong presence onstage and unpredictable performances. They have played a most diverse collection of stages including rock festivals and opera houses gathering an enthusiastic and steadily growing audience. Their concerts are characterized by trembling intensity, lyrical joy, spontaneous escapades and a feeling of strong community.
